



As the new year dawns, I would like to pass along an old message, "Contend earnestly for the faith." These are challenging times for the church. There are obvious external pressures, but there are also internal pressures. It was the internal pressure that concerned the apostle Paul more than the external pressures of a society that was anti-Christ when he met with the Ephesian elders as was recorded in Acts 20. He was concerned that the end result would be a departure from the faith. He could see men within the church, even among the eldership, that would go astray and take the flock with them.

May that situation serve as an example for us. The pressure church leaders feel is real. There is pressure to please men, pressure to be contemporary/relevant, pressure to conform, etc. This pressure often brings pain along with it. This pain can be as severe as possibly losing a long-term friendship or even a family relationship for taking an unpopular stand. Or, it can be exactly the opposite such as thinking it won't hurt to let this one thing go, or to let this happen one time. Regardless of the stimulus, the result can be the same. There is a temptation to move from where one had previously stood.

When one moves slightly others will follow. However, as others follow the tendency is for them to move farther than the one they followed. So, instead of having a slight movement there can ultimately come a major departure. Nobody originally sought that; it is the nature of progressive movement.

We must make sure that doesn't happen among us. Who could imagine that having someone who doesn't believe everything the way the Bible teaches on salvation speak on a non-salvation topic would hurt anything? Should we really expect prospective elders and deacons to meet all of the scriptural qualifications? Times have changed, so shouldn't we do what people will respond to today? Each of these questions (and a multitude of others) represents real issues the church faces today. How the church leadership responds to those issues is the seed that will bear the fruit for the future.

Jude said, "Contend earnestly for the faith." Paul said, "Stand firm in the faith." John said, "I have no greater joy than this, to hear of my children walking in the truth." Please determine that as we move another year further away from the time when Christ lived on the earth and another year closer to the time he will return to the earth, that when he comes he will find the faith on the earth.
