2025-26 CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Restoration Acres is a tremendous blessing to Person to Person Ministries. Every year P2PM undertakes an effort to maintain, expand, or improve our ministry and property in various ways. These projects will help us preserve our present facilities for long-term use.

1. Equipment

P2PM is blessed with 168 acres of property; about 100 of these acres are useable for campsites, buildings, roads, ballfields, shelters, etc. Maintaining the grounds known as Restoration Acres can be a daunting task. About 90 acres of grass needs to be mowed weekly during the warm months, roads need to be graveled, trees need to be cut, asphalt needs to be repaired/sealed/replaced, ditches need to be dug, buildings/shelters need to be maintained and improved, not to mention the many electric/water/sewage needs that must be dealt with on a continuing basis. To accomplish these types of things, much equipment is needed such as tractors, mowers, backhoes, chainsaws, gators/golf carts, etc. We are still determining our most pressing needs which will be presented soon.

2. Road Improvements

Due to heavy traffic, weather and age, the front driveway/road is in need of repair as it leads up to the Guard Shack. Asphalt repair and/or replacement can be very expensive. We will be receiving quotes for the necessary work and will present more accurate information as soon as possible.

Total goal: \$55,000.00 If you can give toward this year's Campaign, we need your donation as soon as possible but we would like to have them all in by March 31, 2026.
