

# 2023-24 CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Restoration Acres is a tremendous blessing to Person to Person Ministries. Every year P2PM undertakes an effort to maintain, expand, or improve our ministry and property in various ways. These projects will help us preserve our present facilities for long-term use.

- 1. New Roof on Tractor Barn (\$17,000)** The "tractor barn" houses all our equipment (tractors, mowers, tools, equipment, etc.). The barn is 45 years old and is in need of a new metal roof. Due to the rust and holes that have developed over the years, replacing the roof with 28-gauge metal is a much better solution than epoxy/paint. A new metal roof will have a 40-year warranty.
- 2. Asphalt Repair and Sealing (\$21,000)** From the moment you enter Restoration Acres, you can see the need for asphalt sealing and repair. Certain sections of our paved roads need attention so that the asphalt can remain in good condition for years to come.
- 3. Campsite Improvement & Development (\$10,000)** Since Family Camp continues to attract new campers, we need more campsites, especially for larger RVs. Twelve new campsites were added to Restoration Acres in 2022-23 but there is always a need for more. New campsites require new electric boxes, water spigots, etc. While we improved and upgraded several campsites, many existing campsites need further improvement (electric boxes upgraded, etc.). This need for improvement and development will continue for years to come.
- 4. Children's Ministry Improvements (\$12,000)** The number of younger families attending Family Camp continues to increase, which means more kids! Before next year, the concrete pad in the Kiddie Korral will need to be replaced. We are looking forward in the next few years to other possible improvements and/or additions that will benefit our children/youth (playground equipment, new ball-court, etc.).

**Total goal: \$60,000.00** If you can give toward this year's Campaign, we need your donation as soon as possible but we would like to have them all in by March 31, 2024.
